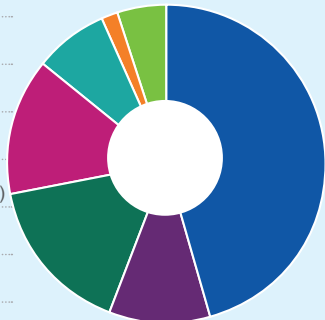

Your local Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) fund most NHS services in your local area.

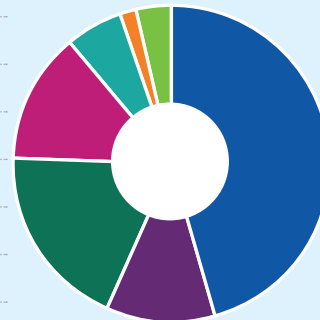
North Staffordshire - Total expenditure £279m

- Acute £127.6m (45.8%)
- Mental Health £28.7m (10.3%)
- Community £44.7m (16%)
- Prescribing £38.4m (13.8%)
- Continuing Care £21.1m (7.6%)
- Running Costs £4.7m (1.7%)
- Other £13.5m (4.8%)



Stoke-on-Trent - Total expenditure £371.1m

- Acute £171.8m (45.6%)
- Mental Health £42.6m (11.3%)
- Community £71.2m (18.9%)
- Prescribing £50.2m (13.3%)
- Continuing Care £21.6m (5.8%)
- Running Costs £5.8m (1.5%)
- Other £13.6m (3.6%)



How much do local services cost?

Here are the average costs for various appointments across North Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent.....

A&E (visit to A&E)
= **£105**

Operation
(planned day case) = **£657**
 Operation
(including one night hospital stay) = **£2924**

Ambulance
(emergency admission)
= **£1569.50**

MRI scan = **£174**

Outpatient Appointment
(1st appointment) = **£119**

Outpatient Appointment
(follow up appointment) = **£70.50**
